

Parent Access to MyHomework App

The myHomework app helps AES Middle Tier students gain the organization and self-discipline skills necessary to academic success.

For parents, the myHomework app is a good way for you to keep up with what your child is working on and whether or not he/she is keeping up. Below please see instructions for setting up your access to your child(ren)'s MyHomework App account.

The myHomework app can be downloaded on Android and iOS devices, Kindle Fires, or accessed through a web browser.

Following one Student

Students' myHomework accounts are linked directly to their AES Google Accounts. **Do not use** your child's AES Google Account to access myHomework. Instead **create your own login** for your child's myHomework account by following the 4 steps below:

1. Have your child login to his/her account from the website (myhomeworkapp.com/login) or through the MyHomework app → using his/her AES Google Account.

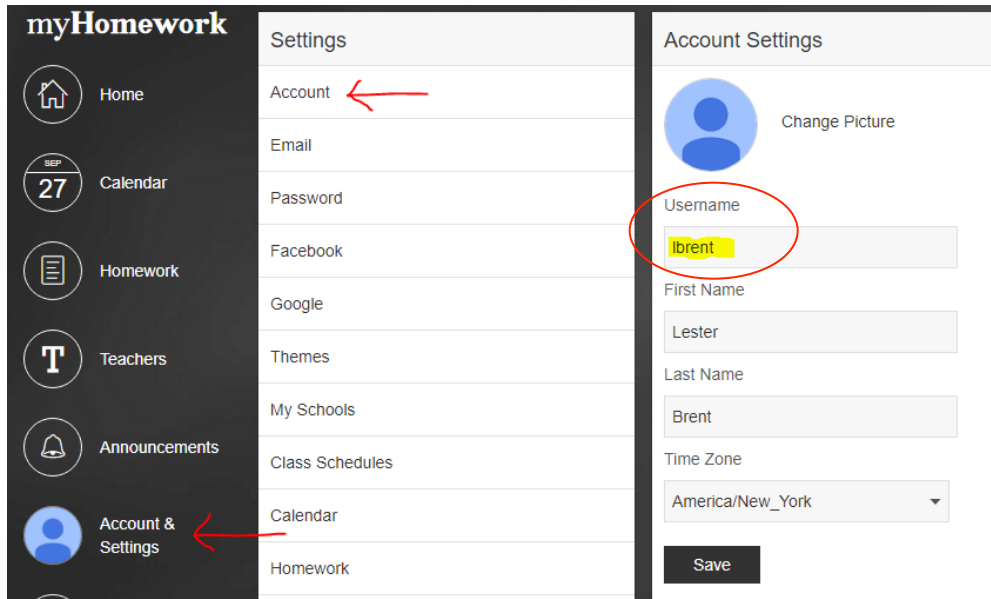

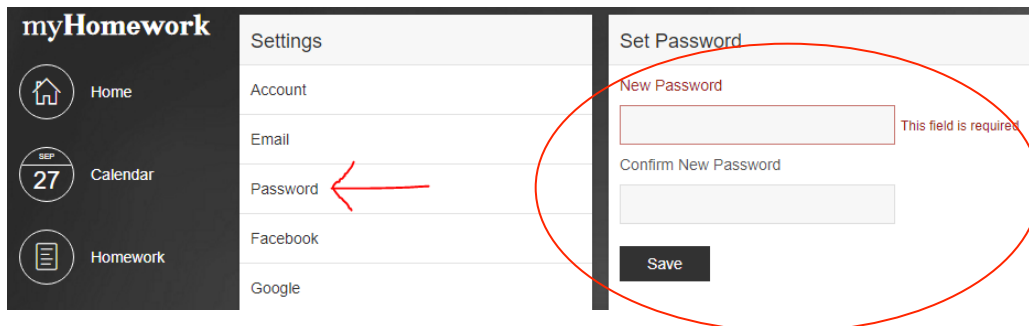

2. Write down your child's username found in the Account & Settings screen. You will need this in order to login on your own computer or device.



3. Next, click on “Password” in the middle column to set the password **YOU** will use with your child's Username (the one you just wrote down).



4. Sign out of your child's myHomework account completely then log in using your child's Username and the password (you just set) in the previous Steps 1-3. You now have full access to your child's myHomework account.

Following Multiple Students

If you are the parent of more than one student using myHomework, follow Steps 1-4 above for each of your children. This will give you access to each account through their Usernames and the passwords you set (1 per child).
